WEEK 19

National Eucharistic

St. Pascual Baylon is the patron of Eucharistic congresses and Eucharistic associations. His feast day is May 17th.

Pascual was born in Spain on the vigil of Pentecost. He was the second of six children. Pascual had a tremendous love for the Blessed Sacrament from an early age. He would sometimes kneel in the field, facing the church and adore the Blessed Sacrament from the field. During one of these moments, it is stated that Pascual yelled, "He is coming here! There he is."

Pascual entered the Friars Minor at the age of 24, where he humbly served his duties. Paschal spent many hours in Eucharistic Adoration. Often the last Friar to leave the chapel and the first to return in the morning.

While journeying through France, Pascal triumphantly defended the dogma of the Real Presence against heretics, and as a consequence, narrowly escaped death at the hands of a Huguenot mob.

We remember Paschal Baylon most as the "Saint of the Blessed Sacrament." Typically, he spent as many hours a day as he could worshipping before the tabernacle. Because of his faithful devotion, the church has named him patron of Eucharistic congresses and conferences. He died in 1592 at the age of fifty-two.

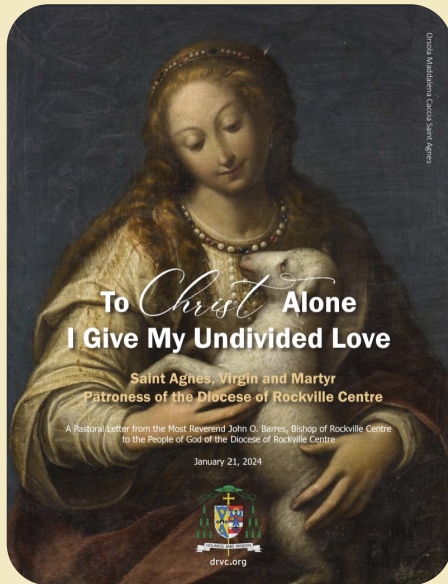

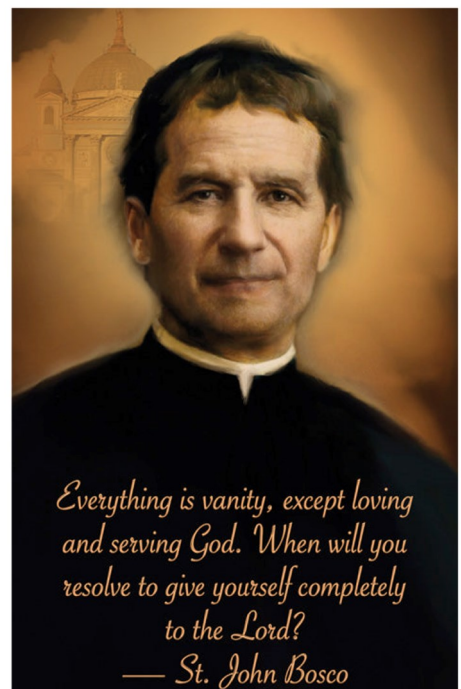


St. Jude Church - Mastic Beach, NY ADULT CONFIRMATION CLASS
