Living Stewardship

Bulletin Reflection

In today's Gospel, we hear how Jesus healed the sick and drove out demons.

St. Vincent de Paul

Jesus rose "very early before dawn" and went out to a "deserted place" to pray, to be in communion with God. He is able to turn his back on the adulation and keep his mission on a steady course because he does not lose sight of why he came—to preach the good news of salvation. He does not lose sight of his mission because he never loses sight of his Father. This is how we reorder ourselves—by praying, being in communion with God so that Jesus' mission is truly our own. (Living Liturgy, p.54) **In our lives as Vincentians, do we have a balance or an unbalance between prayer, service and community?**

WEEK 20

“The Eucharistic Revival that we are now experiencing is a perfect complement to our observance of Lent and Holy Week. Jesus gave himself as a sacrifice for our salvation, and he makes that sacrifice present to us through the Eucharist. He calls us to repentance and conversion of life, and our encounters with him in the Eucharist can strengthen us along the way. When we approach Christ in the Eucharist, we become profoundly aware of our sinfulness, our need for conversion, and our need for God’s forgiveness. Ongoing conversion is a key part of our Lenten journey, a turning away from sin and back to God, and the Eucharist fortifies us against the temptation to fall back into sinful ways. Through the Eucharist, Jesus gives us the resolve to make the decisions we need to make if we wish to persevere in holiness.”

HERE'S WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

Ash Wednesday is on February 14 (Valentine's Day)

Lent lasts 40 days (excluding Sundays)

The three pillars of Lent are: prayer, fasting and almsgiving.

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fasting (one primary meal and two lesser meals) and abstinence from meat.

All Fridays in Lent are days of abstinence from meat.

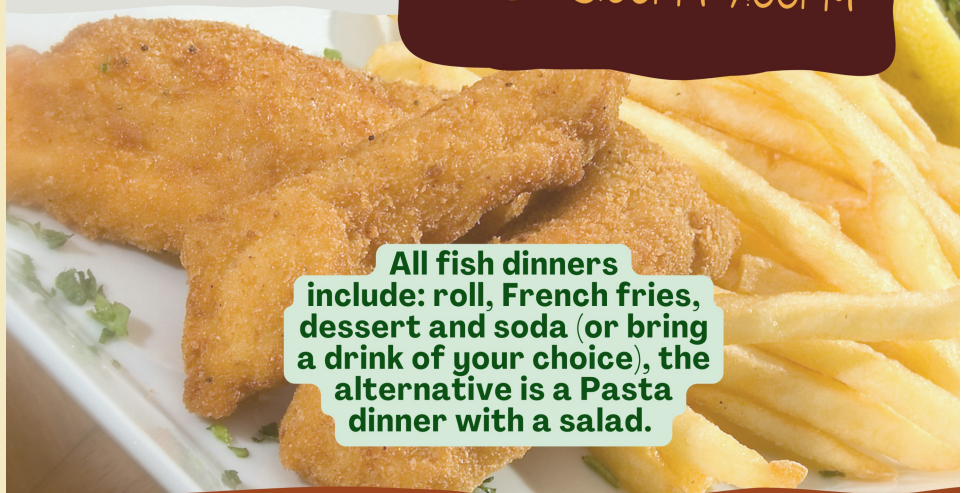

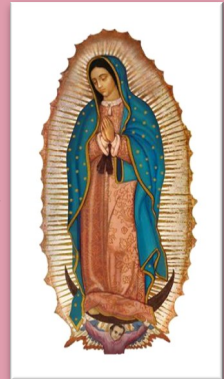
